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#### SECTION IV - HEALTH HAZARDS

EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE:

INHALATION: Contains Ethylene Glycol N-Butyl Ether in concentrated form and may cause irritation to the nose and throat.

SKIN CONTACT: Prolonged contact with concentrated form can cause moderate to severe irritation to skin.

EYE CONTACT: In concentrated form, will cause severe burns to the eyes.

INGESTION: In concentrated form, may cause burns of mucous membranes of the mouth, throat, stomach and esophagus.

#### SECTION V - FIRST AID PROCEDURES

EYES: Immediately flush eyes with water for a minimum of 15 minutes while holding eyelids open. Contact a physician.

INHALATION: Remove to fresh air.

SKIN: Wash thoroughly with water. Get medical attention if irritation develops.

INGESTION: If conscious,, give 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Get medical attention.
